A Resolution To Create an Ad-Hoc Committee to Appoint Senators to Fill the Vacant Senate Positions

WHEREAS: Following the AS elections in the Spring 2019 quarter, there was no candidate who had declared their candidacy and therefore was elected to serve for College of Creative Studies Senator, and open On Campus Senator position(s) with no official runner-ups to contact to fill said vacancy, and;

WHEREAS: It is important that these vacancies are filled as soon as possible to ensure that the 70th Senate runs smoothly and is properly able to address the needs and concerns of the constituents belonging in both the College of Creative Studies and the university residence halls, and;

WHEREAS: A proper application will be released to the UCSB community and made accessible to any undergraduate student who is either currently enrolled at the College of Creative Studies, or who will reside in a university residence hall and will continue to reside there for the entirety of the school year and the duration of the 70th Senate, as stated in Article III, Section 1 of the ASUCSB Constitution. This application will be shared widely via the Senators’ public Facebook accounts and through any other forms of mass communication, including but not limited to social media, and;

WHEREAS: The committee will also reach out to students, if any, who have inquired about fulfilling the position, to let them know of the application and interview process, and;

WHEREAS: An ad-hoc committee chaired by the First Pro Tempore shall be created to ensure candidates for each of the vacant Senator positions are properly selected and then recommended to be approved by the Senate after a thorough review and interview process, and;

WHEREAS: The final candidates for the vacant Senator positions shall be selected by at least a 50%+1 vote within the ad-hoc committee and then approved by at least a 2/3 approval by the full Senate no later than Week 4 of the Fall 2019 quarter to ensure that the two constituencies are adequately represented as soon as possible, and;

WHEREAS: Members of this committee would include:

Senator Tianna White (Chair, Non-Voting),

Senator Daniel Segura-Esquivel (Vice Chair, Non-Voting),

5 additional Senators who express interest and full dedication to the committee, and who shall be appointed by the Chair after a thorough application process and;

WHEREAS: As stated in Article X, Section 4 of the ASUCSB Constitution, the President, Internal Vice President, and Committee on Committees chairperson shall be considered as non-voting, ex-officio members of the Committee, and;

WHEREAS: Voting privileges in this committee will be restricted to the five appointed Senators. Any other Senator is allowed and encouraged to be part of the committee but will be considered an ex-officio member, and;

LET IT BE RESOLVED BY THE 70th ASSOCIATED STUDENTS SENATE ASSEMBLED: That an ad-hoc committee be created to ensure the fair and timely process of selecting and recommending candidates to fill the vacant College of Creative Studies Senator and On-Campus Senator position(s) in the 70th Senate.
